
BARIATRIC AIR SYRINGE

INDICATIONS:

For intraoperative leak testing of a gastrojejunal anastomosis or gastric closure.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

TO TEST A GASTROJEJUNAL ANASTOMOSIS OR GASTRIC CLOSURE:

- 1. Immerse the anastomosis or closure in a pool of saline.
- 2. Attach the BARIATRIC AIR SYRINGE to a gastric tube via the CONNECTOR. Alternatively, remove the CONNECTOR and attach the male Luer slip directly to the gastric tube.
- 3. Compress the INFLATION PUMP slowly and repetitively to inflate the bowel.
- Observe the MANOMETER and inflate until the desired intraluminal pressure is reached.
 DO NOT OVERINFLATE. OVERINFLATION MAY DAMAGE OR RUPTURE A SUTURE OR STAPLE LINE.
- 5. Observe the saline pool for bubbles, which indicate an air leak.
- 6. Repair the anastomosis or gastric closure if necessary and repeat the leak test.
